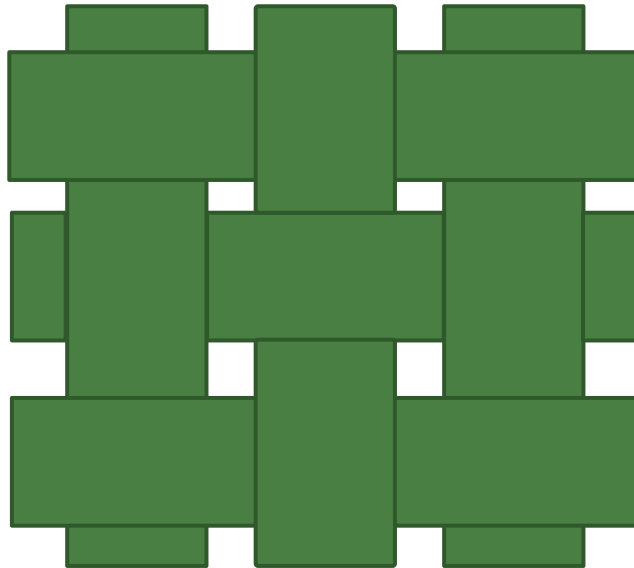

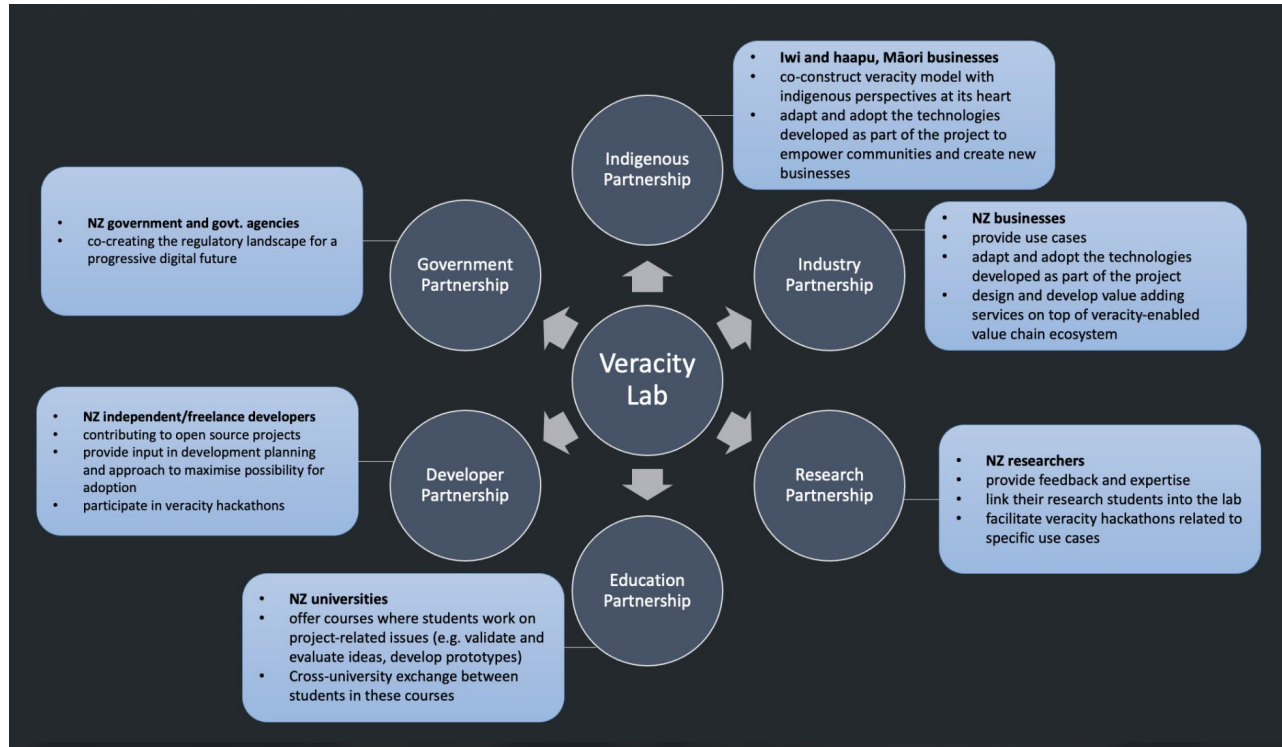

Partnership Model





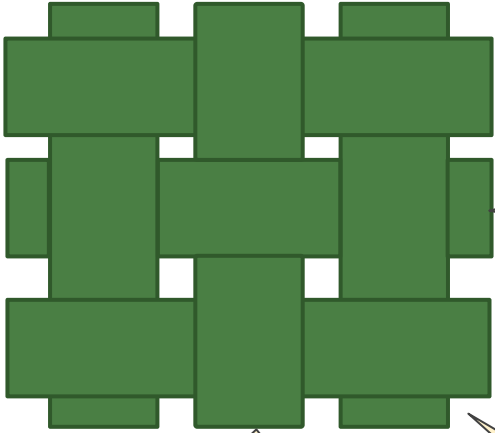
